Police Order No. 01 of 2020

Sub: Preparation of Range Approved List (RAL) of Police Office Clerks for promotion/appointment to the post of Upper Division Clerks, Cashier, Accountant, Reader Clerk and Head Clerk.

Consequent upon creation of new Police Districts, Police Commissionerates, Battalions and other units, it has been felt necessary to re-group the districts, police commissionerates, battalions and units for the purpose of preparation of Range Approved List (RAL) of Lower Division Clerks for promotion to the post of Upper Division Clerks and Upper Division Clerks for promotion/appointment to the post of Cashier, Accountant, Reader Clerk and Head Clerk.

2. It is also felt necessary that the districts, police Commissionerate, battalions and units are re-grouped in such a manner that the original inter-se seniority of staff in the erstwhile ranges and offices is maintained in spite of creation of new formations.

3. In view of the above, the following Range Boards are hereby constituted for preparation and maintenance of RAL in supersession of Police Order No.01 of 1996 and/or any other order or orders issued in this respect in the past.

Police Order No. 02 of 2020 Dated the 2nd November, 2020

Sub: Duties and Functions of Traffic Units in West Bengal Police.

It has been felt necessary to issue instructions specifying the role and functions of traffic headquarters, traffic control rooms and traffic units in the Districts/Police Commissionerates for proper functioning and supervision of these units. Therefore, in modification of various instructions issued earlier, the following orders are hereby issued for compliance with immediate effect:

A. Duties and functions of 'District Traffic Headquarters':

- 1. Supervision of district / City Traffic Control Room.
- 2. Tasking and supervision of field traffic units.
- 3. Planning, implementation and documentation of road safety campaigns.
- 4. Planning and monitoring of road safety strategies.
- 5. Supervision of investigation of road traffic accident cases, entrusted to traffic wing.
- 6. Coordinating with local stakeholders RTOs, MVIs, PWD/NHAI engineers, etc. as well as with District Road Safety Committee.
- 7. Reporting to Traffic HQ, West Bengal, as necessary.
- 8. Functioning as District Record Bureau of all crime statistics related to RTAs and traffic prosecutions.
- 9. Supervision of provisioning and maintenance matters in respect of road traffic furniture.
- 10. Holding inspections of subordinate units.
- 11. Planning matters relating to leave of the staff posted in the traffic wing of the Commissionerate / district.
- 12. Assisting Superintendent of Police/Commissioner of Police in matters relating to leave, training and discipline of all subordinate traffic police personnel in the district / Commissionerate.

Note : Subject to the control of Superintendent of Police / Commissioner of Police and strategic guidance of Traffic HQ, the District Traffic Headquarters shall be headed by an officer of the rank of at least a Deputy Superintendent of Police in the district and Deputy Commissioner of Police in a Commissionerate.

B. Duties and functions of 'Traffic Control Room' in Districts / Cities :

- 1. Functioning and manning on 24 X 7 under the charge of one Inspector to be known as Officer-in-Charge, Traffic Control Room.
- 2. Coordinating and documenting all information pertaining to incidents and flow of road traffic, both within and outside the district, with Control Rooms of Traffic HQ and Police HQ.
- 3. Alerting and coordinating with agencies for first responder action with police and non-police components like Ambulance, Hospital, Road Engineering, Fire Services, Disaster Management Group, Transport Department etc. in case of VIP Movement, Traffic Congestion, Road Traffic Accident.
- 4. Keeping a continuous watch on the monitors connecting the feeds from various CCTVs installed in the Commissionerates and Districts and Sub-Divisions and maintaining event diary.
- 5. Keeping continuous watch on TV channels for traffic related news.
- 6. Collecting other traffic related information like Safe Drive Save Life campaigns, traffic check-posts, prosecution drives, special traffic diversions, etc.
- 7. Assisting DCP/ACP/Dy. SP in charge of Traffic police in preparation of daily sitreps, daily manpower and traffic furniture deployment reports and fulfilling other reporting obligations related to traffic.
- 8. Any other duty assigned by supervisory officers from time to time.

C. Duties and functions of 'Traffic Guards':

- 1. Planning and regulating local traffic movement.
- 2. Manning and supervising all traffic posts.
- 3. Deployment and maintenance of road Traffic furniture.
- 4. Alerting and coordinating action for all road engineering interventions like road signs/signage, road markings, signals, illumination etc.
- 5. Undertaking road safety campaigns for community like schools/colleges/ bazaar samitis and targeting groups like drivers of ambulances/taxis/ autos/medium and heavy commercial vehicles.
- 6. Taking up investigation of Road Traffic Accident cases entrusted to traffic wing.

- 7. Ensuring speedy trial and processing of insurance/ex-gratia to victims in coordination with concerned departments.
- 8. Launching prosecution in respect of traffic violations under MV Act.
- 9. Keeping a watch on traffic related news items.
- 10. Reporting progress on Safe Drive Save Life campaigns, traffic check posts, prosecution drives, special traffic diversions, etc.
- 11. Fulfilling other reporting obligations related to traffic.
- 12. Any other duty assigned by superiors.

D. Duties and functions of the 'Highway Traffic Guards':

- 1. Managing highway traffic challenges like congestion, restriction and diversion as a first responder.
- 2. Launching prosecutions against traffic violations.
- 3. Keeping continuous watch on health of road infrastructure and road furniture.
- 4. Supervision of working of static and mobile watch towers.
- 5. Conducting road safety awareness programme in establishments falling within 500 meters of the edge of the highways in their jurisdiction.
- 6. Taking up preliminary investigation into Road Traffic Accidents within 50 meters from the edges of the highways, evacuating victims, arranging immediate medical attention, extricating vehicles and restoring highway traffic.
- 7. Ensuring speedy trial and disbursal of insurance / ex-gratia to victims in coordination with concerned departments.
- 8. Acquiring knowledge of vulnerable/black spots on highways and coordinating with engineering departments to ensure their correction and rectification.
- 9. An other duty assigned by Superintendent of Police/Commissioner of Police from time to time.
- 10. The revised composition of various Highway Traffic Guards is given in Annexure.

Highway Patrols, it is hereby ordered that the Highway Traffic Guards will function with combined strength and functions of Highway Patrols in the The Government had sanctioned Highway Patrols in some districts to regulate the traffic and guard the highways. Recently, the government has existing Highway Traffic Guards vide memo No 1043-PL/PB/3P-24/19 dated 09/06/2020. Now, to streamline the function of Highway Traffic Guards/ sanctioned additional posts of 10 Inspectors, 22 Sub-Inspectors, 27 Assistant Sub-Inspectors, 166 Constables and 59 Police Drivers for the 17 new and revised jurisdictions as noted below. The Highway Traffic Guards shall be under charge of an Inspector designated as O/C Highway Traffic Guard.
